

## FRENSHAM LTC RETURN TO PLAY REQUIREMENTS

### ACCESS TO CLUB GROUNDS

- You must be a fully paid up playing member of the club or joined by a family member who is. Please ensure that play can be maintained at an acceptable level. Balls ending up on adjacent courts too frequently will be disruptive.
- You **must not** be a member of a household in self-isolation, have no symptoms and not been out of the UK in the last 14 days.
- You must have a booked a court prior to arrival. One spectator is permitted but social distancing must be maintained at all times.

### BOOKING COURTS

- All bookings must be made in advance online using **Clubspark**.
- Initially courts can be booked for 1 hour only. **Booking made in excess of 1 hour will be removed.**
- Initially we request members only book one slot in advance during the first 4 days. An additional court booking can be made if slots are free on the day.
- We will monitor court usage and we will look at options to extend these arrangements once the initial rush has subsided.

### ARRIVING AND LEAVING THE CLUB

- The Clubhouse will remain locked for the foreseeable future and should only be accessed if the **First Aid box** is required.
- Please arrive no more than a couple of minutes before your booking slot.
- Access to the courts is through the side gate next to the cricket club changing room. Please do **NOT** go past the bowls green.
- Signage will direct you and waiting areas if players have not yet vacated your court.
- Members are required to sanitise their hands both before and after using the padlock. Sanitisers are provided but ideally members will bring and use their own sanitiser.
- The padlock code will be provided to paid up members.
- Please observe social distancing at all times.

### DURING PLAY

- The following formats are permitted:-
  - o Singles between members of the same or different households.
  - o Doubles when all players are from the same household.
- Each household must use their own balls – **none** will be provided by the club.
- We suggest you use a limited number of clearly marked balls. If they stray onto the adjacent court we suggest you request their return at the first convenient opportunity.
- When you return balls please use either your racquet or foot.
- Once you have finished playing please leave the club area.
- **PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF PLAYERS ON THE ADJACENT COURT AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING.**
